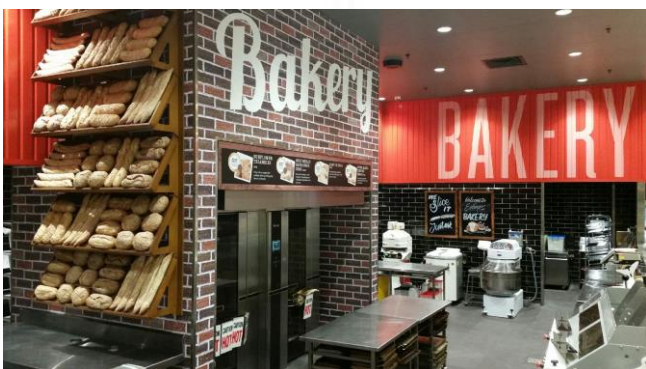

Food Grade, Hygienic, Anti-slip flooring systems

Epoxy / Polyurethane Toppings – Most common type of flooring, typically applied to back of house preparation areas, including Deli, Meat, Produce, Seafood and Bakery areas.

Screeds / Graded Falls – Profloor have wide experience in creating falls to drains with epoxy mortars. Often a difficult / detailed job, ensuring that the end product does not pond.

Covings – Hand formed covings are installed on site by our team, using epoxy mortars. We can increase the coving height and thickness to suit various wall finishes including tiles, arrowheads and stainless.

Linemarking / Sealing – Profloor also offer packaged floor solutions to include sealing of back of house areas, coolrooms & carparks, Linemarking of safety walkways and demarcation zones, and installation of truck lines, to assist in store deliveries.

CASE STUDY - Coles Wetherill Park - NSW

Profloor had been approached by Brookfield Multiplex Constructions to carry out the installation of all back of house flooring and linemarking, for the conversion of 2 existing retail tenancies, into a major supermarket. A total of 1000m² of Polyurethane was installed, including 550m² of screeding to falls.

Profloor faced a number of new challenges, typically not associated with a standard fitout including:

- Preparation & Patching of 20 year old concrete slabs over 2 tenancies
- Installation of Mechanical Jointing systems
- Re-screeding of floors to new drainage layout and to eliminate prior tenancy set-downs
- Expansion joint and concrete repairs to stockroom slab
- Installation of an ultra smooth, hard wearing finish to stockroom, able to withstand high volumes of pallet and fork traffic
